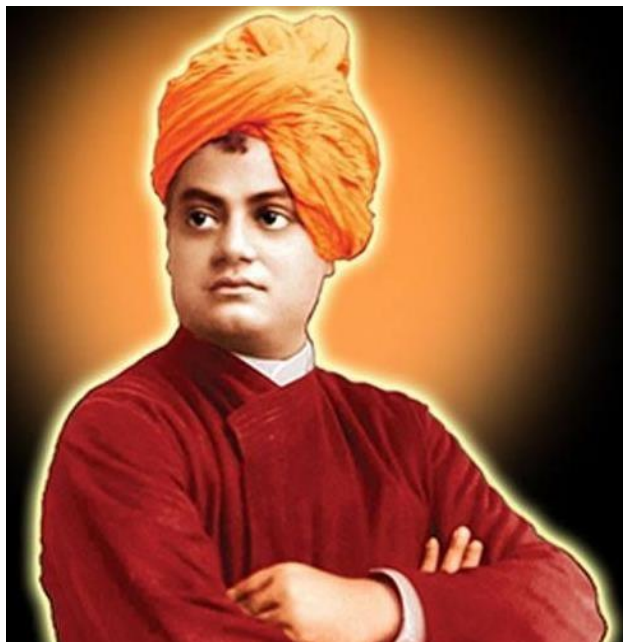

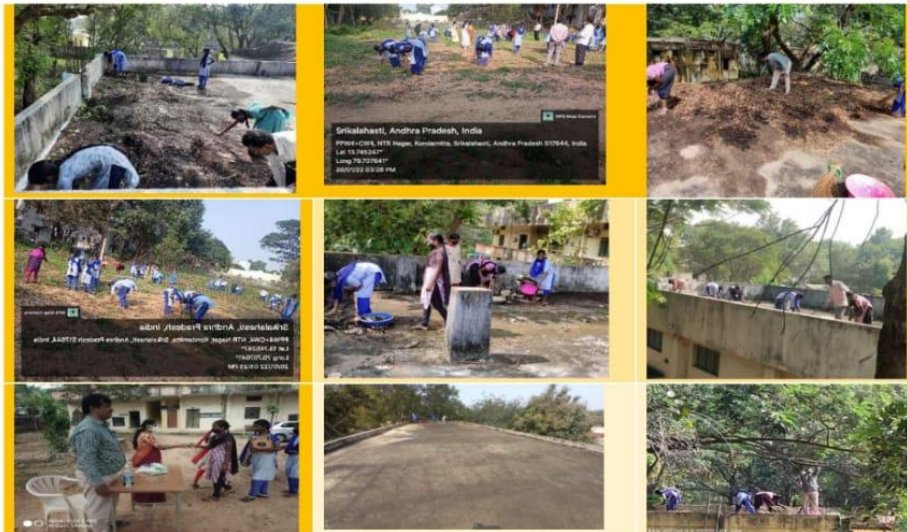


Activity Report

REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATIONS (73rd Republic Day)



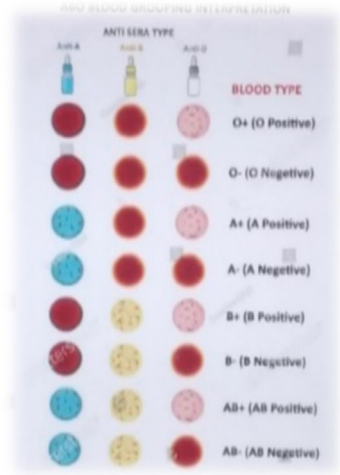

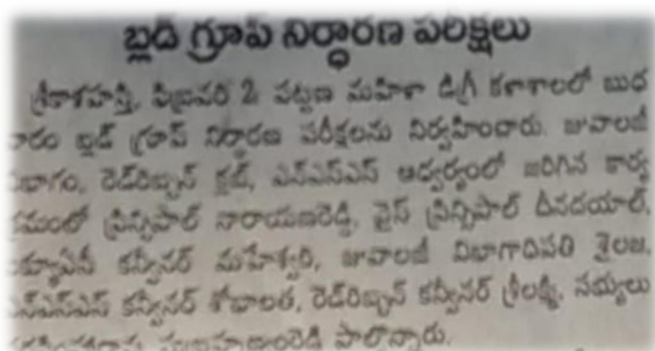
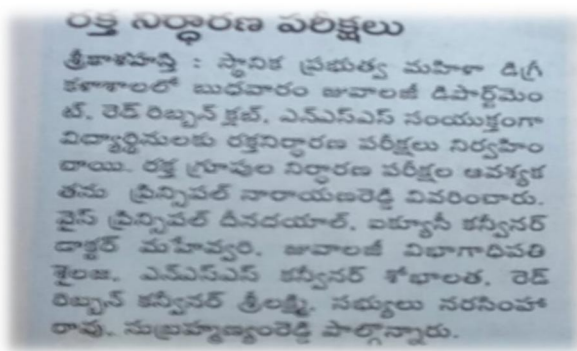
are enlightened the student with the importance of Republic Day. Prizes were distributed to the winners of various competitions held on the college level and DRC Programme.

World Cancer Day

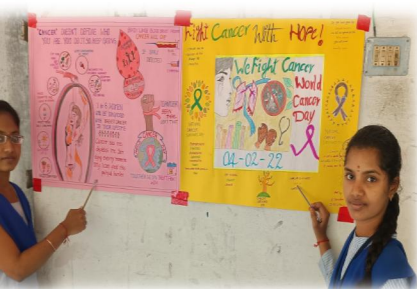

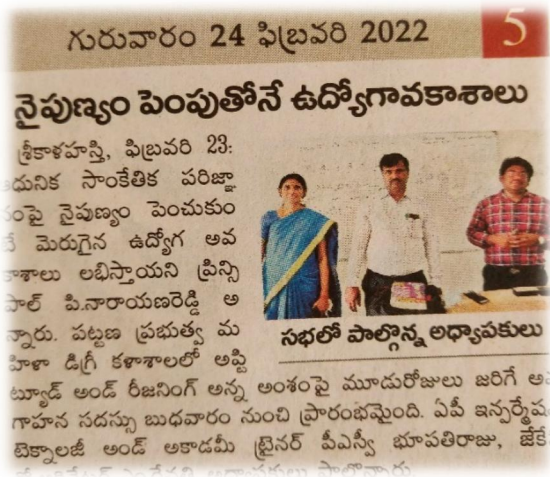
3-Day Workshop on “Aptitude and Reasoning” By Andhra Pradesh Information and Technology Academy (APITA)

Growth assessment is the measurement that best defines the health and nutritional status of children, while also providing an indirect measurement of well-being for the entire population.

We suggest that school age is the active growing phase of childhood and primary school age is a dynamic period of physical growth as well as of mental development of the child. NSS volunteers took out the physical measurements like body weight, height, circumference of arm and calf to assess health and nutrition status of community.

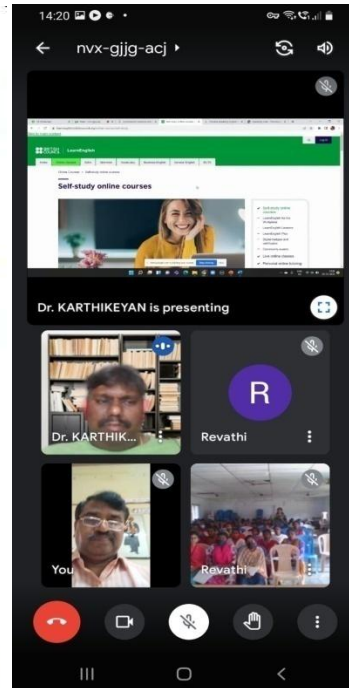

Principal Dr P Narayana Reddy stressed that conversations are key for language development.

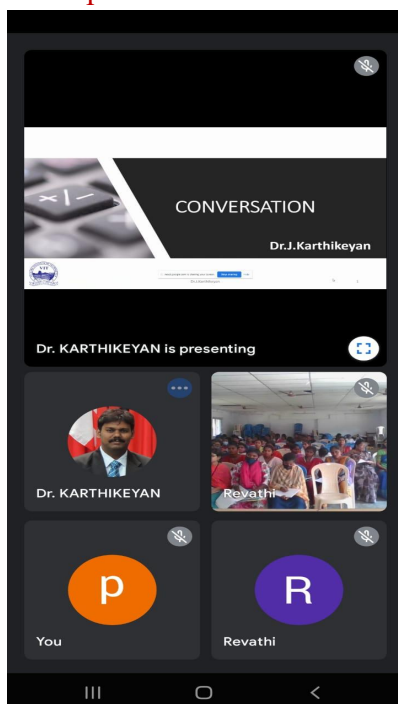

WORLD LABOUR DAY



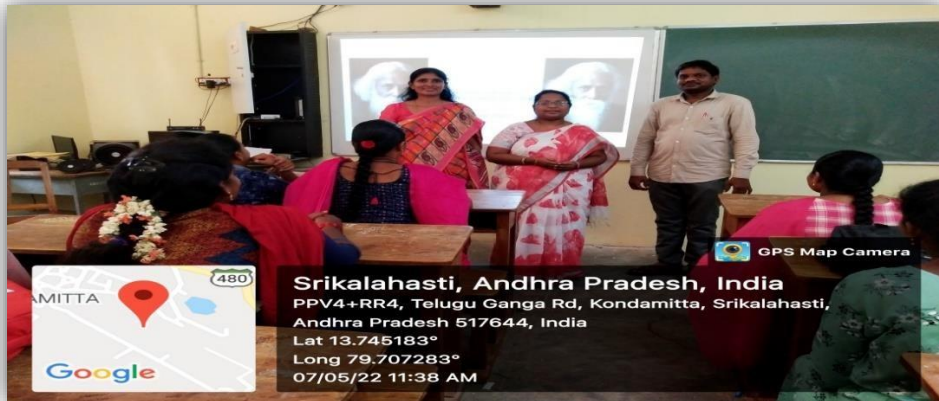

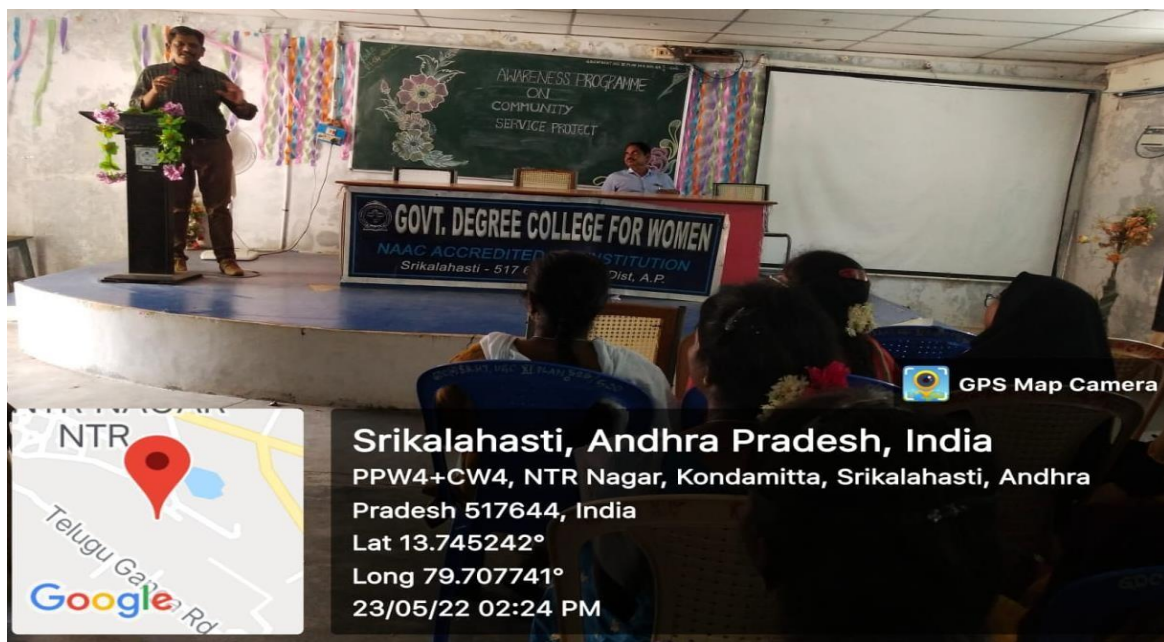

International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Drug Trafficking

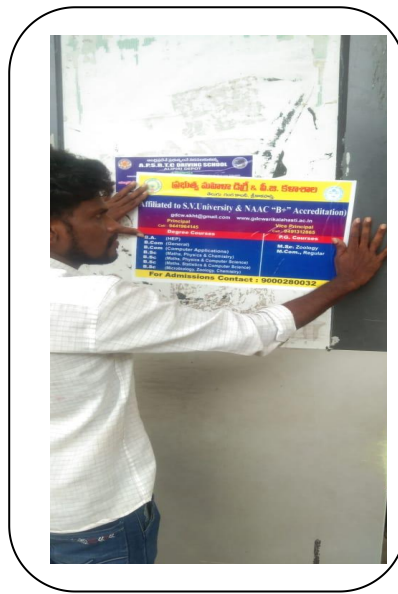

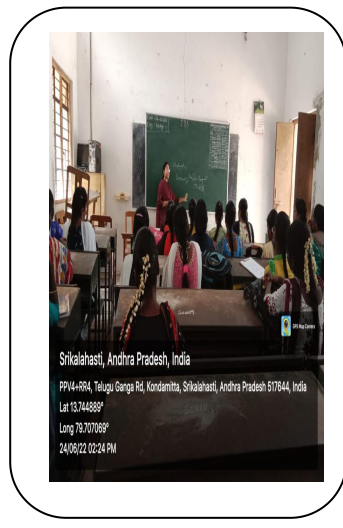
