Observation of International Blood Donors Day on 14th June, 2023

On 14 June 2023, World Blood Donor Day is celebrated throughout the world. Officially designated as an annual event by the World Health Assembly in 2005, the Day provides a special opportunity to celebrate and thank voluntary blood donors around the world for their gift of blood and has become a major focus for action towards achieving universal access to safe blood transfusion. Every single donation is a precious life saving gift and repeat donation is the key to building a safe and sustainable blood supply. In many countries, blood services face the challenge of making sufficient blood available, while also ensuring its quality and safety, Lack of access to safe blood and blood products — especially in low and middle income countries,

impacts on all patients, including those requiring regular transfusion. One of WHO strategies is to assist low- and middle-income countries in improving the availability and quality of human plasma, including optimising the utilisation of the plasma recovered from whole blood donations, and increasing patients' access to the life-saving plasma protein therapies.

Focus of this year's campaign

The slogan for 2023 World Blood Donor Day campaign is "Give blood, give plasma, share life, share often." It focuses on patients requiring life-long transfusion support and underlines the role every single person can play, by giving the valuable gift of blood or plasma. It also highlights the importance of giving blood or plasma regularly to create a safe and sustainable supply of blood and blood products that can be always available, all over the world, so that all patients in need can receive timely treatment.

On 14 June 2023, World Blood Donor Day is observed. The Department of Zoology and Microbiology jointly conducted an awareness programme on Blood Donation and explained the importance, Benefits of Blood donation and precautions to be taken by the donor at the time of blood donation is added.

International Yoga Day on 21st June 2023

Due to Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi's relentless efforts, June 21 was declared as the International Yoga Day by the United Nations General Assembly. In its resolution, the UNGA endorsed that "Yoga provides a holistic approach to health and well-being apart from striking a balance between all aspects of life. The wider dissemination of information about the benefits of practising Yoga would be beneficial for the health of the world population." This infused an era of holistic health revolution in which attention was given more to prevention rather than the cure.

Centuries ago one of the most popular Sanskrit poets Bhartrhari, while highlighting the specialty of Yoga, said that by regularly practising Yoga, a person can imbibe some very good qualities like courage which protects like a father, forgiveness as possessed by a mother & mental peace which becomes a permanent friend. 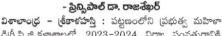
Pamphlet distribution through Daily News Papers and Door to door Admissions campaign

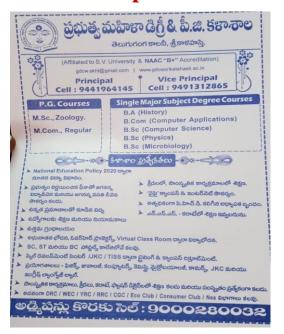
