## DAY-1 (05-02-2026)

### *Session -1:*

**Topics of Discussion:** Introduction to Cyber security

**Objectives:** Introduce cyber security concepts, scope, and importance of protecting digital systems and data

**Description:** Explained definition of cyber security, its scope in daily digital life, and importance through real-life examples and awareness discussion.

**Outcomes:** Participants understood basic cyber security concepts and importance of safe digital practices.

### *Session -2:*

**Topics of Discussion:** Branches of Cyber security, Information Security Principles, Phases of Hacking, Hacking and Real world Incidents, Usage of AI and its security landscape

**Objectives:** To introduce major cyber security domains, explain security principles, and create awareness about hacking phases, real-world incidents, and AI related security risks.

**Description:** Explained different cyber security domains and specializations, information security principles (CIA triad and key concepts), basic phases of hacking for awareness, firewall concepts including IDS and IPS, real-world incidents, and AI-related security risks.

**Outcomes:** Participants gained awareness of cyber security domains, understood basic security concepts, and recognized emerging risks related to AI and cyber threats.



## DAY-2 (06-02-2026)

### *Session -1:*

**Topics of Discussion:** Recap Session, Networking Basics, Firewalls (IDS/IPS), Real-world Technical Security breaches and their case studies, Secure Architecture and its safety measures

**Objectives:** To reinforce previous concepts, introduce networking fundamentals, explain firewall and IDS/IPS roles, and create awareness about secure system architecture and real-world security incidents.

**Description:** Conducted a recap session followed by introduction to networking basics, explanation of firewalls and IDS/IPS, discussion on real-world technical security breaches, and overview of secure architecture practices.

**Outcomes:** Participants understood basic networking concepts, security defense mechanisms, and importance of secure architecture in preventing cyber attacks.

### *Session -2:*

**Topics of Discussion:** Principles of Internet and Network Architecture, Phishing Website and Malicious Link Identification, Google Dorks, Shodan CCTV Exposure, Data Leaks (OSINT)

**Objectives:** To explain internet and network architecture concepts and create awareness about phishing attacks, exposed devices, data leaks, and information gathering risks.

**Description:** Explained internet and network architecture principles, demonstrated identification of phishing websites and malicious links, and introduced concepts of Google Dorks, Shodan exposure, and OSINT-based data leaks for awareness.

**Outcomes:** Learned to identify phishing links, and gained awareness about online data exposure and safe internet practices.



## DAY-3 (07-02-2026)

### *Session -1:*

**Topics of Discussion:** Recap Session, OSINT and Public Information Gathering, EXIF Metadata Awareness, Data Breach Awareness, Financial Cyber Safety (UPI Scams)

**Objectives:** To reinforce previous concepts and create practical awareness on online safety, data privacy

**Description:** Conducted recap on internet working and phishing methods, explained OSINT concepts, EXIF metadata risks, data breach awareness, financial cyber frauds.

**Outcomes:** Participants gained practical awareness on identifying online threats, protecting personal and financial data.

### *Session -2:*

**Topics of Discussion:** Fake Malware APK Identification, Malware Detection Techniques, AI Safety Awareness, Deepfake Identification, App Permissions and Phone Security, National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal, Cyber Crime Complaint Process, Personal Cyber Hygiene

**Objectives:** Financial fraud prevention, mobile security, AI-related risks, and cyber crime reporting procedures.

**Description:** Fake APK identification, malware detection basics, AI and deepfake awareness, mobile permission management, and demonstrated cyber crime reporting procedures.

**Outcomes:** Managing device security, and understanding official cyber crime reporting mechanisms.
