

No Plastic Day

Objectives of the Practice:

- To create awareness among students, staff, and the community about the harmful effects of plastic on the environment.
- To promote eco-friendly and sustainable alternatives to single-use plastic.
- To encourage behavioral change and make the campus a plastic-free zone.
- To contribute towards environmental conservation through collective action

The Practice:

- The college observes “**No Plastic Day**” **regularly**, during which students and staff avoid bringing or using any single-use plastic items such as water bottles, covers, cups, and straws.
- Awareness rallies, poster presentations, and seminars are organized to highlight the ill effects of plastic.
- Cloth and jute bags are promoted as alternatives, and distribution drives are conducted.
- Departments, canteens, and administrative sections are advised to minimize plastic usage and adopt reusable materials.
- Volunteers from NSS and Eco Club actively participate in clean-up drives in and around the campus.

Evidence of Success:

- Visible reduction in the use of single-use plastic items on campus.
- Students and staff have started using reusable bottles, cloth bags, and eco-friendly products.
- Increased awareness among the local community through outreach and campaigns.
- The initiative has strengthened the college’s commitment to environmental sustainability and green campus practices.
